<u>Instructions for WeChat Video – Lesson 1</u>

- 1. Watch the whole video. (Don't stop to translate words)
 - a. You need to use headphones to hear all the words.
- 2. When Jeremy or I say, "Now you try!", you need to repeat the sound, word, or phrase out loud.
 - a. These are speaking lessons, so you need to speak!
 - b. Pay attention to the new sound you are learning. Try to say it clearly.
- 3. Say the tongue twister, practicing the "th" sound.
- 4. When I say "Quiz Time!" I will say a list of words and you need to listen to the words, choose the word you hear, and write it down.
 - a. You can check your answers at the bottom of the page. The correct word will be in red.
- 5. After you watch the video, go down the page and read the words to the video.
 - a. Use your dictionary or translator to look up words you don't know.
 - b. Write the new words in your notebook with the meaning in your language.
- 6. Check your answers to the quiz.
- 7. After you read and understand all the words, watch the video again. You can read the English subtitles this time.
 - a. Remember to say the words and phrases out loud!
- 8. You can stop the video and go back to listen to a difficult part more than once.
- 9. You should watch the video more than 2 times. Then, write a WeChat message to me about what you learned in the video.
 - a. For example: "I learned how to say yes/no questions." "I learned that the word "design" means to make."

10. Type your ideas or click the speaker to send a speaking message.



11. To find the video again later you can go to the BCNC English page and type "1" or "th" and it will come up. To see the next videos, type and send the number of the lesson.
