Google Classroom

- A learning management system (LMS), similar to Blackboard or Canvas, which facilitates interaction between teachers and students
- Available on computers, tablets, and smartphones
- With Google Classroom, you can easily:
 - Communicate with students
 - Share materials with your class
 - Keep track of assignments and grades
 - Give homework, group projects, and individual assignments



Joining and creating classes

- To create a class, go to Google Classroom (on any device) and click the plus sign icon.
- To join a class, students need the class code or invite link.
- There may be restrictions on who can join, depending on your organization's Google settings.
 - “A school with students” message (with personal account)



Classroom components

- Classes
- Stream
- Classwork
- People
- Grades



Stream

- A class message board or “News Feed”
- Teacher or students can post (by default)
- Attach links, files (from Google Drive or your computer), or YouTube videos
- Move posts to the top
- A good place to post a Zoom link
- Adjust to your preferences in Class Settings

Types of classwork

- Question – short answer or multiple choice
- Assignment
- Quiz assignment
- Material



What can you add to classwork?

- Google Docs, Slides, Forms, etc. (new or preexisting)
- YouTube videos
- Links
- Files uploaded from your computer/device
- Google Drive files



Other classwork features

- Assign to all students or only some (differentiation!)
- Points
- Due dates
- Scheduling
- Rubrics
- Editing
- Reusing posts



Topics

- An important organizing tool
- Organize by date, subject, type of activity, etc.
- Library of recommended resources
- Program information
- Advising resources

A student's perspective

- Click on “Sample Question.” Type your response under “Your answer,” then click “Turn in.”
- Click on “See classmate answers” and reply to other people’s responses.
- Click on “Sample Assignment.” Follow the instructions to complete the assignment. Be careful – you may be graded on this! 😊
