- Connect officially or just post links (better for privacy)
- Quizizz and Padlet examples

 - “Your work”
 - Private comments
- Teacher's Perspective
 - Student work/answers
 - Grades and returning work



Other aspects to note

- Classroom settings
- Co-teachers
- Integration with:
 - Google Drive (Classroom folder)
 - Google Calendar
 - Google Meet (in some cases)
- Upcoming, To do (students), and To review (teachers)
