

### Sample Writing Workshop Session Schedule

<b>Introduce New Vocabulary (related to unit)</b> <i>Also: an idiom a day (suggestion)</i>	15 minutes
<b>Mini-Lesson: (suggestions)</b> Grammar, Editing, Digital literacy, Reliability of sources, The writing process, Prewriting activities, Lesson from <i>Final Draft</i> )	30-45 minutes
Writing	1 hour
Sharing/Feedback/Workshop discussion	1 hour

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<b>Writing Warm-Up:</b> journaling or writing to respond to a prompt (prompt may be related to lesson topic)	15 minutes - 25 minutes
<b>Mini-Lesson:</b> Introduce a new style of writing- Model and release- Read one or more examples that demonstrate the style of writing to be performed- Identify the important elements that distinguish the style of writing-	45 minutes - 1 hour
Writing - using a prompt for the required writing style	45 minutes - 1 hour
Sharing/Feedback/Workshop discussion	30 minutes - 1 hour
